

Blue Moon Cruisers Meeting Minutes
February 3, 2015
Park Inn, Mechanicsburg, Pa. 17050

The meeting was brought to order by President Dana Moore at 7:05 p.m. with 77 members in attendance per the roster sheet. President Moore asked for roll call of officers and board members. The following officers and board members were not in attendance: Glen Keller, Stephanie Fisher, Simon Williams, and John Kaufman.

President Moore asked for the reading of the minutes from the January 6, 2015 meeting. The meeting minutes from the January meeting were read by Donna Savidge. Motion was made by Barb Bloom and seconded by Sheri Forry to accept the minutes as presented. Motion was carried.

President Dana Moore informed us that three individuals from the Pa. Turnpike Commission were in attendance to present us with a presentation pertaining to the 75th Anniversary celebration of the Pa. Turnpike Commission. They were Carl DeFebo, Renee Colborn, and Chrissy Baker. Carl DeFebo announced that October 1, 2015, was the actual Anniversary Date. He presented a video of the history of the turnpike. Renee Colborn talked about the events being planned.
